Shotover Heli Raft

Transfer into Skippers Canyon via helicopter and then raft from Deep Creek over peaceful waters at first heading toward the exhilarating rapids of the lower Canyon, experiencing the memorable rapids Rock Garden, Sharks Fin, Toilet Bowl, Pinball, Jaws, Sequel and the unforgettable 170m Oxenbridge Tunnel, followed closely by the Cascade Rapid.



Coronet Peak Paragliding

Treat yourself to an incredible experience. You will enjoy breathtaking views of this scenic New Zealand landscape, taking off from the highest take off in Queenstown, Coronet Peak. Enjoy the exhilaration of hang gliding or paragliding with one of their experienced tandem pilots. The scenery is simply breathtaking. All tandem pilots are fully licensed instructors, there to give you a thoroughly exciting, enjoyable and educational experience. Have a relaxing scenic flight or an adrenaline pumping joy ride, the choice is yours!



The Kawarau Bridge Bungy is an exciting 43m drop above the spectacular Kawarau River. Take the plunge from this Department of Conservation Historic Reserve just 20 minutes from the heart of Queenstown. Forwards, backwards, by yourself or with a friend... it's up to you. It's also the only Bungy in Queenstown where you can choose to bob over the water, touch it or get fully immersed. For the well keen adrenaline junky, the Nevis Highwire Bungy is a wild 134

metres (440 feet) drop – approx. \$260 pp. Also available at this different site is The Nevis Arc, the world's highest swing – approx. \$180 pp.

Skippers Canyon Jet

Recognised as one of Queenstown's best value products. Getting there is half the fun! The Skippers Canyon Road, carved from schist rock, travels along sheer canyon walls and through some of the greatest scenery New Zealand has to offer. Visit Lord of the Rings locations and learn of the pioneers amazing feats of engineering as your driver explains the history of mining relics which scatter the banks of the Shotover River.

You will then enjoy an exhilarating Jet Boat ride through the canyons of gold allowing access to remote places such as the site of the first

incredible gold discovery. Feel your adrenalin surge as you skim the Shotover's shallow waters at speeds of 80 km/hr and experience the famous Hamilton jet spins.





Shotover Jet

It's an amazing ride, as the Shotover Canyon walls tower over you, and your driver skilfully whips the boat past rocky outcrops, and skims around the crags and boulders.

Rock faces blur in your peripheral vision, the opaque water sprays into myriads of white crystals with every turn. You grip the safety rail for comfort and reassurance and then let out a whoop of excitement as the driver spins the boat around in its boat length – wow; you have just experienced the 'trademark' Shotover Jet 360 degree spin!

Milford Fly / Cruise / Fly

You will be taken for a glorious flight over the spectacular scenery from Queenstown to the stunning Milford Sound. This captivating flight takes you over alpine lakes, glaciers, lush rainforest and past rugged peaks. When you have reached your destination you will be treated to a cruise aboard a small boutique cruise ship so you can view the amazing wildlife up close. You will also indulge in a lovely morning or afternoon tea aboard the boat. After your cruise you will be accompanied by your friendly pilot back to the plane and flown again through the magnificent scenery back to Queenstown.

Golf is in abundance within the Wakatipu Basin with 4 excellent courses all within 20 minutes of central Queenstown. Enthusiasts from around the world enjoy Millbrook, Queenstown, Arrowtown and Jack's Point courses with their challenging holes and spectacular scenery.
